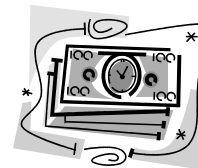
## LOOKING FOR HELP

- Positively no arrivals before 9 A.M. Friday, June 29.
- There are **NO** hook-ups, so come with your gray and black water tanks empty and your fresh water and batteries full.
- You will need your up-pipe.
- For pet owners, be sure to have your pets paper work in order.
- There is a dump station. Last year we could use it at no extra charge, but the year before we had to pay extra.
- Last year we had a hard time to take on water. We hope to have these situations taken care of this year well in advance.
- This rally is situated in a large open field next to the Cape Cod Canal. There is the ocean, with a beach; a 7 mile paved walking /bike/roller blade path right along the canal.

- When you get to Scusset, check in at the check in center.
- At the field, you will be greeted and given a packet.
- Inside will be a two part card with a number.
- For emergency purposes, please place the larger card in your coach windshield and the smaller card inside your tow car on the windshield or dashboard.
